• Completed entry form (front & back) with required signatures

• ALL signed documents and Covid-19 releases

•Current coggins

• 14-day in and out of state health certificate

• Proof of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus vaccinations within 6 months prior to entering the competition grounds

• Copy of Horse Registration

• Copy of current PFHA/USEF membership cards for all Riders, Trainers and Owners

• USEF Safe Sport Training

• Form of payment- emailed entries must include signed credit card payment

Horse Stall Fees: Showing & Non-Showing Horses \$325/stall includes one(1) complimentary Pre-Spectrum Class. Stalls are 12x12 air conditioned, matted stalls w/ door

ALL horses will be charged a stall fee- no ground fees available

Tack Stalls: \$325

Pre-Entry: \$325 Entries MUST be received by midnight on 02/19/23

Post-Entry: \$100 per horse for entries received after 02/19/23

Pre-Spectrum: \$70 per class, \$90 if added at show **Spectrum:** \$125 per class, \$150 if added at show

<u>Class Scratches:</u> Will be issued 50% refund if done the day before class, scratches done on same day as class will be non-refundable. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** <u>OFFICE FEE:</u> \$20 Per Horse

50% refund of entry fees issued with Vet Certificate only. Horses will not be able to compete once Vet Certificate is received. Stalls are non-refundable.

Stalls may only be transferred from one owner to another if all stalls are sold out. Upon receipt & approval of transfer request form (available at show office), person receiving stall will be charged full staff fee & person transferring stall will receive refund minus a \$50 handling fee

Refunds will be issued within 30 days from last day of show

Horses will not be allowed to be taken from show grounds without written release from Show Secretary

Warm up Ring: Only Horse, Rider and Handler will be allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Inspections: Before entering the arena, all Exhibitors will be asked to go through a check in area and their horse will be inspected by the Inspection Farrier and the PFHA Steward. All Exhibitors will come with their horse tacked up but with bit in hand for Steward Inspection. Only the bit that is inspected will be allowed in the holding area. Once in holding area, if bit needs to be changed, the Exhibitor and horse must go back through the inspection area, if time permits. **NO SPURS PERMITTED IN HOLIDING AREA.** Horses tack is to be competition ready for the class showing. No training equipment of any kind will be allowed in the holding area, this includes additional bits, draw reins, strings etc. Bags/pails will be inspected. The Inspection Farrier will be checking for lameness and the legality of shoes. Trainer, owner, or Exhibitor may assist in lifting feet. Any horse refusing to have all four hooves inspected will not be allowed to compete. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Exhibitors shall be familiar with the rules prohibiting soreing as per Paso Fino Horse Association rules, Chapter Two, IV, Paragraph E; and with rules concerning shoeing as per Paso Fino Horse Association rules, Chapter Two, IV, Paragraph C.

Horse Move In Date: Monday, 3/20/22 after 9:00 a.m.

PARKING: Horse Trailer Parking is **NOT** Permitted in barn area. Horse trailers **MUST** be parked in designated trailer parking area

<u>CLASS CALLS</u>: Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system. However, due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate 30 minutes prior to the start of their class

DOGS ON COMPETITION GROUNDS: Dogs **MUST** be on a leash at all times on show grounds

DAMAGE: World Equestrian Center hold individual owners and exhibitors responsible for damages incurred by them, or their agents, to barns or other properties on the show grounds and will bill them accordingly. Florida PFHA, Spectrum International Show and/or Show Management will in no way be responsible for any loss/damage that may occur. It will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show, its management and World Equestrian Center blameless for any loss or accident to his/her horse(s) or equipment that may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. Florida PFHA, Spectrum International Show, World Equestrian Center will not be responsible or liable for injuries sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, employees or any other interested parties.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and /or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
